WALKING ARCHERY COURSE RULES

Archery equipment can be very dangerous and must therefore be handled properly and SAFELY. In case of an emergency, dial 911. To report any unsafe conditions, contact a Park Officer by calling 564-2291.

COURSE CLOSED NOVEMBER 1 TO MARCH 31 DUE TO THE WINTER ACTIVITIES NEARBY.

- 1. FIELD TIPS ONLY. ABSOLUTELY NO BROADHEADS. FIREARMS ARE PROHIBITED.
- 2. Prior to each shooting session, the Archer should carefully check bows and arrows to make sure both are in proper state of repair.
- 3. Archers <u>must</u> stay on the trail and walk the course in order, starting from Station 1 and ending at Station 14.
- 4. Do not load arrows until the shooting area is cleared.
- 5. Use the buddy system if possible. One person should warn any approaching archers that the second person is retrieving arrows behind the target.
- 6. If you are shooting alone: only retrieve arrows beyond the target after you **securely** place your bow on the target. This shows other shooters you are in the target area. <u>Do not shoot at a target that has a bow leaning on it.</u>
- 7. Shoot only at designated targets in the appropriate shooting area.
- 8. No more than six (6) arrows will be shot at one shooting time.
- 9. Only shoot at distance that allows you to consistently hit the target. Move closer to target if needed.
- 10. Never shoot an arrow up in the air.
- **11.**Alcohol is prohibited. Persons who have been consuming alcohol or are under the influence of drugs are prohibited at the range.

A list of Safety Rules cannot address all situations. Archery Range users are expected to be Safety-Conscious and Responsible at all times.
