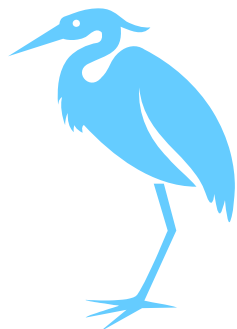
If you enjoy the outdoors, like having fun, and want to meet and work with a diverse group of people then this may be the volunteer group for you.
