**Committee Reports**

**Assistant Park Manager**-Norm Swann reported that a new “Water Trail” with 9 stops around the lake has been created, along with a brochure for interested participants. The dam near Route 87 will need to be replaced and the state and county will be involved. New signs are ready to be installed at the park entrance. The siding on the Chalet will be replaced and there are new restrooms at Tinkers Creek State Park. The Pizmohts are working on improving the multi-use trails. The park will be getting recycling barrels for cans, bottles, plastic and paper at no charge for recycling. The Friends agreed that recycling in the campground would also be beneficial.

**Membership Recruitment**-The Friends of Punderson is growing and the group would like to encourage new members to join. Attending meetings is not mandatory and “friends” are encouraged to join to assist on projects that may be of interest to them.

**Board President update-**

**Website/Newsletter**-Sandy Swann asked for pictures of projects and the campsites that are not posted on the web. People have favorably commented on the campsite photos. Sandy will work with Katrina to determine how to send a receipt and thanks to donors. Sandy asked for members to send information about schedules, programs, events, and volunteer opportunities.

**Park Facility/Campground Update**- In order to do the trail work, an excavator is needed. Don Pizmoht obtained quotes from local businesses. Bill Spear of Spear Chardon Tractor will donate the use of the excavator, a \$540 in-kind donation, provided it isn't sold. It needs to be picked up and returned to his business. The Siberian Husky Club of Greater Cleveland plans to work on the trails on September 13 and 14<sup>th</sup>. The Club will donate \$150 in fuel.

**Special Events Update**-Plans and publicity has started for the *Halloween Fun Fest on Saturday, October 11 from 3:00-9:00 p.m.* The event is being held for the campers and the surrounding community and it will feature cider/donuts, cookie decorating, scavenger hunt, crafts and games and a hayride. Free stuff basketball, pumpkin roll, candy and prizes, the raffle at \$1 per ticket. Time permitting, a tour of the cabins or lodge rooms might also be included.

There will be prizes for the costume context. So far the event has been advertised at the playground and Geauga County Fair. Katrina will send out a press release and email blast.

**Financial**-Volunteers are selling tickets for the raffle and so far the *Friends* have made \$54. The current balance in the *Friends* account is \$ 5769.83 balance.
