

- **A**lcoholic Beverages Prohibited
- **C**ampsites
 - **Check in / Check out:** Check in is after 3pm, Check out is before 1pm
 - **Expired Tag:** Please return your expired site tag to the camp office on departure and place in the mailbox on the side of the building
 - **Occupancy:** Up to 6 people are permitted to camp on one site
 - **Occupancy, Group Site:** Up to 25 people are permitted to camp on one group site
 - **Picnic Tables & Fire rings:** Each site has 1 picnic table & 1 fire ring. Please do not borrow picnic tables or fire rings from unoccupied sites
 - **Questions????:** See the Camp Staff or the Camp Volunteers (recognized by the campsites with the sign “Camp Host” in front) with any questions or concerns you might have. **If you would like to apply to become a Camp Host, please contact Park Staff for more information and an application.**
- **E**nvironmental / Health
 - **Dishes:** Please wash your dishes at your campsite and dispose of the gray water in the block receptacles provided at various locations throughout the campground. Do not wash dishes at the drinking fountains or the restroom sinks.
 - **Firewood:** Please check information about the Emerald Ash Borer before you transport any firewood
 - **Fires:** Keep fires contained in the fire rings provided
 - **Lanterns:** Keep lanterns away from the bark of trees
 - **Leave no trace:** Please do not litter.
 - **Trails:** Stay on established trails. Please keep bicycles on paved roads.
 - **Vegetation:** Do not collect, pick or damage live plants including trees and flowers
- **P**ets are welcome in the campground with the following restrictions:
 - **Leash:** Must be on leash or in secure enclosure (cage) at all times
 - **Noise:** Excessive noise (such as continued barking) is not permitted
 - **Number:** Up to 2 pets are permitted on one site
 - **Prohibited Areas:** Pets are not permitted in any buildings or on the sand at the beach
 - **Sanitation:** Please clean up after your pet. Mutt Mitts are available in various locations throughout the park
- **Q**uiet Hours are between 10pm and 7am
 - **Visitors:** No Visitors after 10pm
- **U**nderage Campers (under 18 years old camping without parents) are required to have a permission slip from parent or legal guardian with a phone number where the parent can be reached in case of emergency
- **V**ehicles
 - **Children:** Be aware of children playing and riding bikes on or near the camp roads. Watch for blind spots where children may appear suddenly such as in front of or behind the Camp Office (please stop at the STOP signs)
 - **Parking:** Please do not park vehicles on the grass
 - Boat trailers may park at the campsite (in the grass), at the parking lot next to the camp store, or at the parking lots at the Marina
 - **Passes:** 1 vehicle pass is issued with each reservation
 - Additional vehicle passes may be purchased for \$2.00/day
 - You may park additional vehicles in the parking lot next to the camp store for no additional charge
